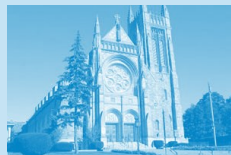

Take a look at new titles in our media and book rack! Here is an excellent opportunity to do some summer reading or listening to grow in your faith.

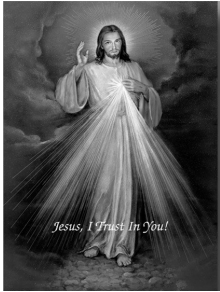
